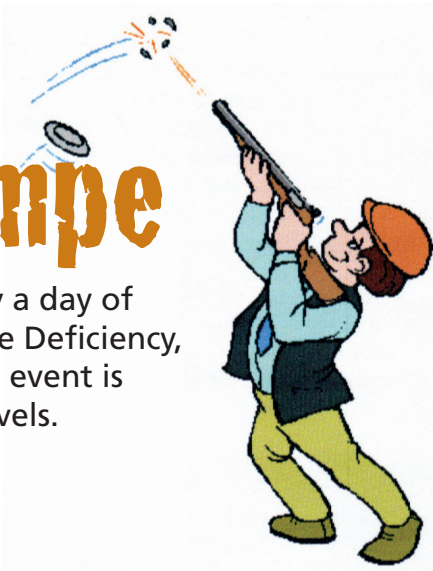

The Acid Maltase Deficiency Association, formed to assist in funding research and to promote public awareness of Acid Maltase Deficiency, also known as Pompe Disease. Pompe disease is one of a family of 49 rare genetic disorders known as Lysosomal Storage Diseases or LSDs. Pompe disease is also known as Acid Maltase Deficiency or Glycogen Storage Disease type II. At one time, AMD was a death sentence, now, there are treatments coming on line but still no cure.

Raising funds for an organization like AMDA is difficult at best. The number of people impacted by this disease is relatively small (1 in 40,000) when compared to cancers and other respiratory illnesses such as asthma. It is when that small number includes one of your own, that it takes on new meaning.

Tiffany House, daughter of PCMA's Butch House, Bexar Concrete Works in San Antonio, has firsthand experience with Pompe. First diagnosed at 12 years old, Tiffany missed most her adolescent years and experiences as the disease progressed, but recent treatments have provided her with opportunities unheard of only a decade ago.

Emerging treatments have made it possible for Tiffany to earn her Master's degree in English and she completes her Law studies at St. Mary's University this spring. Tiffany, now 27, is President of Acid Maltase Deficiency Association, our proposed 2011 fundraiser recipient. Helping this organization helps one of our own, pretty cool.
